

How to find out about your school/organisation

Your school website is the best place to find out about your school, this has a wealth of information for you to read.

Governors will need to ask their school for specific information – the Instrument of Government if your school is local authority maintained school and your Articles of Association, Funding Agreement and Scheme of Delegation if it is an Academy.

There are also general websites to support all types of schools. Visit these and type your school name in the search section to find out your school specific information.
